**NATURE OF POSITION:**

The Cridge Dovetail Services provides services to women, children and families residing in Cridge Supportive Transition Housing. The Child & Youth Care worker provides support services to mothers and children/youth fleeing violence and/or to immigrant refugee mothers and children/youth. Services include individual and group supportive counselling for children/youth; parenting support; socio-recreational activities for children/youth; accompaniment and advocacy for child protection and legal matters related to children/youth; child-minding; and other supports as required.

The job requires a working knowledge of attachment theory and developmental stages of children and youth, the dynamics of relationship violence, and child-centred, trauma-informed service delivery.
