NATURE OF POSITION:

The Cridge Dovetail Services provides services to women, children and families residing in Cridge Supportive Transition Housing. These services are specific to women's safety, relationship violence, and immigration and refugee issues. Services include individual and group supportive counseling; asset building; socio-recreational activities; accompaniment and advocacy for legal, child protection, income assistance, medical, childcare, and other services; support with day-to-day activities such as getting to the Food Bank; and other supports as required.

The job requires a working knowledge of the dynamics of relationship violence, and empowering, client-centred, trauma-informed service delivery.

EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

Minimum 6 months transition house or second stage experience and two years experience in a social services setting.
